

Systematic review of all historical episodes of malaria resurgence

Resurgence:

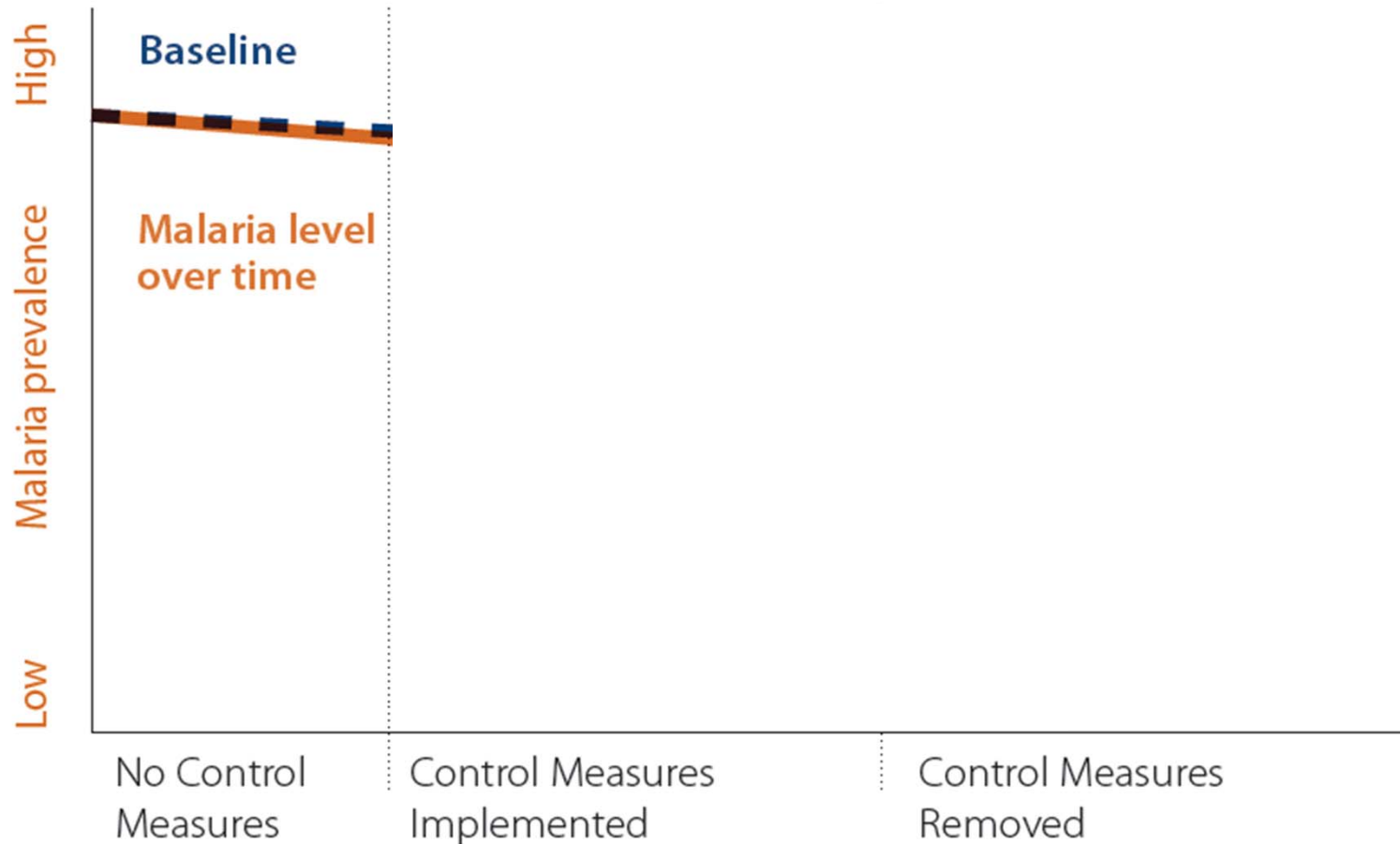
An increasing trend in malaria incidence or prevalence following suppression achieved through implementation of control efforts.



Systematic review identified
75 resurgence events

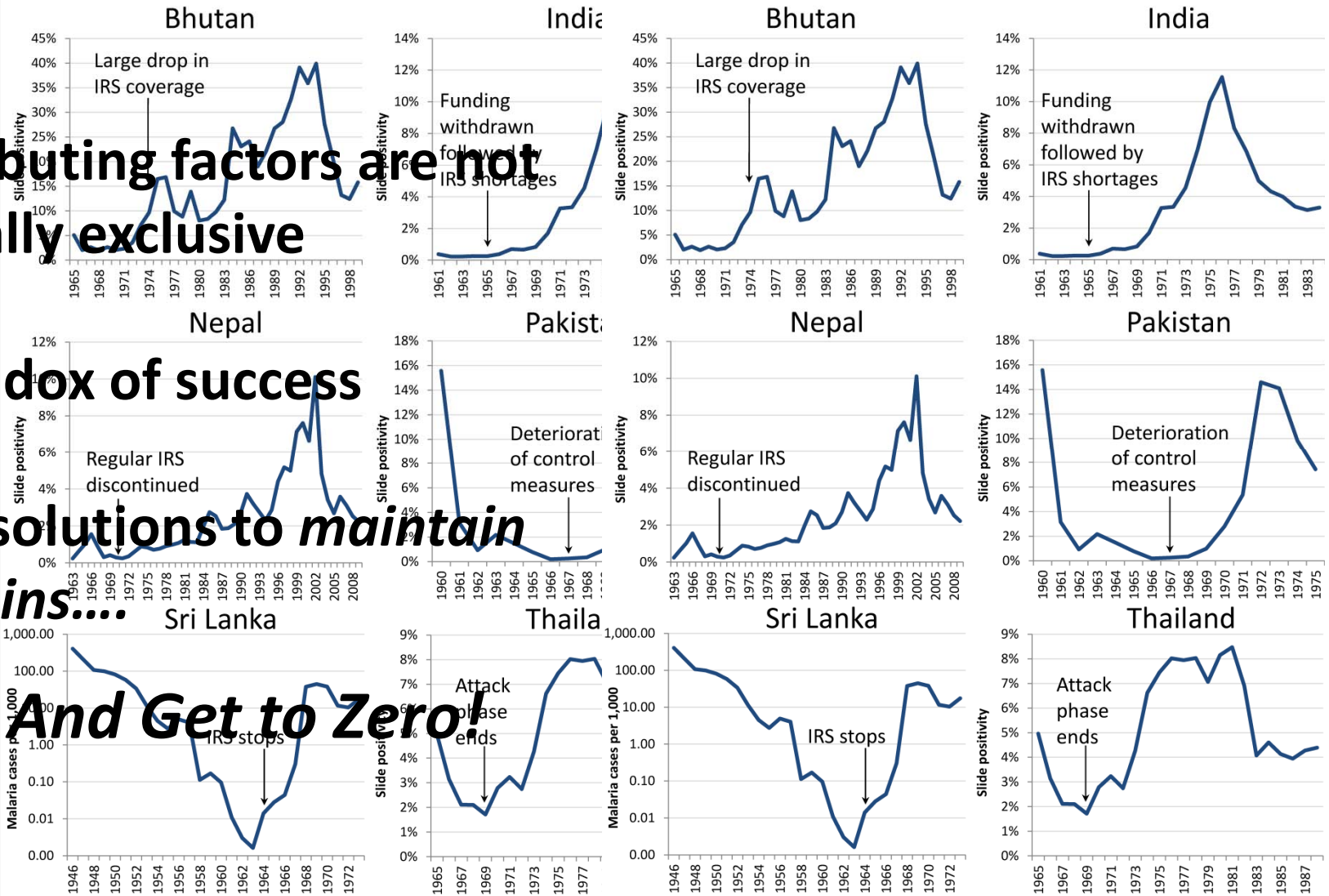
Programmatic weakening
not mentioned as cause
(9%)

Stopping control measures results in a return to baseline prevalence



History repeating itself

- Contributing factors are not mutually exclusive
- A paradox of success
- Need solutions to *maintain the gains....*
